- Support expanded enforcement by
 - Providing citizens with the tools and talking points to reach and engage their community peace officers in AIS prevention and enforcement.
 - Working with the agencies and legislators to ensure second tier watercraft inspectors have adequate enforcement capabilities.
 - Leading a statewide campaign to advocate for larger penalties (fines) for AIS law infractions.
- Support expanded inspections by
 - Directly disseminating AIS prevention information through MW newsletters, website, electronic bulletins, social media, presentations, workshops and special events.
 - Developing niche, targeted messaging, in partnership with business leaders, designed to reach a wide variety of audiences.
 - Working with agencies to promote the increase of AIS outreach/education special grants to local communities.
 - Working with business leaders to create privatized inspection programs and employment opportunities.
 - Leading a statewide campaign to advocate for private enterprise opportunities around AIS education and inspections.
- Support the development of a sustainable, adequate AIS funding source by
 - Researching and reporting on the projected costs and overall economic impact (i.e. tourism industry, property values, related businesses, etc) of taking no new AIS prevention actions
 - Leading a statewide campaign to advocate for increased AIS prevention funding from
 - a watercraft surcharge increase and
 - increased penalties (fines) for AIS law infractions.
- Support the development of programs that are private enterprise-friendly and state endorsed by
 - Working with the chamber of commerce to explore business models that can be supported by local manufacturing, grow small businesses, and create jobs across Minnesota.
 - Working with agencies and business leaders to explore options to seed these new, venture businesses.
 - Developing AIS education content and outreach messaging focused on the importance of conceiving a comprehensive, statewide AIS prevention system.
 - Leading a statewide campaign to advocate AIS prevention programs that enable private business investment and profit.
